HELP PRESERVE ONE OF THE GREATEST MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS IN THE WORLD

Built in 1926 as the largest musical instrument ever conceived and with 8 manual divisions and pedals, 200 draw stops controlling 10,268 pipes, played from two massive consoles it is the largest organ in the UK.

The Grand Organ of Liverpool Cathedral is internationally renowned as one of the greatest church organs in the world but, after 90 years of continuous daily use in worship, the organ badly requires major restoration work. This leaflet shows some of the ways you can help us raise the £900,000 needed to preserve one of the greatest musical instruments in the world.

Whether it is a simple one off donation, supporting us with a fundraising event, adopting a pipe or taking part in a unique Organ Experience we have ways for you to help us reach our target. We've nearly raised 2/3 mark of £600,000 towards our total. With your help we can preserve this magnificent instrument for future generations.
