When they got out of the boat,

You will need: Paper, paint, pens



Mix the colours of paint that you think you will want to use.

Dip your thumb into the colour that you wish to use for Jesus. Make a thumb print in the centre of your paper.

Now use a variety of colours and place thumb or finger prints around the central figure as if they are crowds watching and listening to Jesus.

Let the paint dry and then start to add details with the black pen such as arms, legs, facial features, clothes, etc.

You might want to add some scenery too: rocks, grass, lake, sky, buildings.
