Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 9.28-29, 34-35; for reflection throughout the week)

A cloud came and overshadowed them;
and they were terrified as they entered the cloud.
Then from the cloud came a voice that said,

Things to do

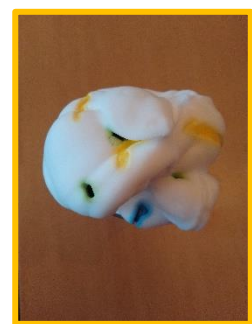
- Research and then try to spot and identify different types of clouds.
- Sew a fluffy cloud cushion.
- Cloud science

You will need: a glass or other see through container, water, shaving foam and food colouring



Fill a glass or clear container with water.

Squirt shaving foam on top of the water to look like a fluffy cloud.



Drop food colouring onto the shaving foam.

Wait and see what happens when the food colouring (eventually!) drips through the cloud, like rain.
