Things to do

- Make a weather data collection equipment to record, rainfall, wind speed and temperature research Stevenson's screens.
- Watch the weather forecast and track how accurate it is
- Paper plate weather chart

You will need: paper plate, pencils or pens, scissors, red card or foam, split pin.





Divide the plate into 4 (or more) sections.

Draw and colour a picture in each section representing a different type of weather



Cut an arrow shape from the red card and attach using the split pin.

Record the weather each day.
