THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Ten lepers (Luke 17: 11-19)

Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 17: 12-16; for reflection throughout the week)

As Jesus entered a village,
ten lepers approached him.
Keeping their distance, they called out, saying,
‘Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!’
When he saw them, he said to them,
‘Go and show yourselves to the priests.’
And as they went, they were made clean.
Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed,
turned back, praising God with a loud voice.
He prostrated himself at Jesus’ feet and thanked him.
And he was a Samaritan.

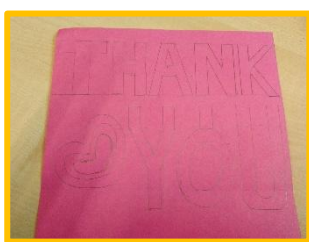
Things to think about

- How often do you say thank you to others?
- How do you feel when others thank you?

Things to do

- Make an effort to say thank you more frequently
- Learn how to say thank you in different languages
- Pop up thank you card

You will need: 2 pieces of A4 card, scissors/craft knife, pencil, glue



Cut one piece of card so it is slightly smaller than the other. Fold in half.

Write "Thank you" in large letters so that "You" is below the halfway fold. Remember to add tails to the tops of 'You' the same distance as below the fold.



Carefully cut out 'Thank' and remove and save the small triangle from the 'A'

Now cut out the outline of 'You' but don't remove from the card.



Fold the letters of 'you' to make them pop out.



Glue the pop up section to the other card, check the folds are correct and decorate the front as you choose.
