THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Beatitudes (Luke 6: 20-31)

Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 6: 20-23; for reflection throughout the week)

Then Jesus looked up at his disciples and said:
'Blessed are you who are poor,
for yours is the kingdom of God.
Blessed are you who are hungry now,
for you will be filled.
Blessed are you who weep now,
for you will laugh.
Blessed are you when people hate you,
and when they exclude you, revile you, and defame you
on account of the Son of Man.
Rejoice on that day and leap for joy,
for surely your reward is great in heaven.'

Gospel prayer (for use throughout the week)

Lord Jesus Christ,
you give to your saints
an unending welcome at your festive table.
Inspire us by the examples
of your people who have gone before us,
that we may share with them
the joys of your eternal reign;
for you are our God.
Amen.

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Things to think about

- How do you feel when you hear that you are blessed by God if you are poor or hungry?
- Why do you think these people have been chosen by God?
- How do you think God will reward you

Things to do

- Make a Bee-attitudes flower: decorate paper flower petals with each of the beatitudes listed in the Gospel reading.
- Beattitudes wheel

You will need: paper plate, pens, paper, scissors and a paper fastener/split pin fastener.



Divide the paper plate into 8 sections.

Write the beginnings of the verses (Meek, poor, peacemakers etc) around the edge of the plate.



Write how they will be blessed in the middle of each section.

Cut a circle from the paper, slightly smaller than the plate. Cut a wedge shape from the circle so that one complete section of the plate can be seen inside.



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Write "Blessed are the..." on the paper

Fasten the paper to the plate and spin the wheel to reveal the complete texts.
