THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Christ the King (Luke 23: 33-43)

Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 23: 39-42; for reflection throughout the week)

One of the criminals who were hanged there
kept deriding him and saying,
‘Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us!’
But the other rebuked him, saying,
‘Do you not fear God,
since you are under the same sentence of condemnation?
And we indeed have been condemned justly,
for we are getting what we deserve for our deeds,
but this man has done nothing wrong.’
Then he said,
‘Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.’

Gospel prayer (for use throughout the week)

Lord Jesus Christ,
you reign from the cross of glory.
Accept and welcome us into your everlasting kingdom,
that we may live under your reign for ever;
for you are our king.

Things to do

- Make time to say sorry to others.

Make a cross from two pieces of card and place on the paper.

Colour around the shape of the cross in different colours.



Smudge the colours together and remove the template.

Using watery paint, paint the hill and sky.
