Core extract from the Gospel (Acts 9: 21-22; for reflection throughout the week)

All who heard Paul were amazed and said,
'Is not this the man who made havoc in Jerusalem
among those who invoked the name of Jesus?
And has he not come here for the purpose of bringing
them bound before the chief priests?'
Saul became increasingly more powerful and confounded the
Jews who lived in Damascus
by proving that Jesus was the Messiah.
