RUNNING WATER

THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Living water brings eternal life (John 4: 5-42)

Core extract from the Gospel (John 4: 10-11, 13-14; for reflection throughout the week)

Jesus answered her,
'If you knew the gift of God,
and who it is that is saying to you, "Give me a drink",
you would have asked him,
and he would have given you living water.'
The woman said to him,
'Sir, you have no bucket, and the well is deep.
Where do you get that living water?'
Jesus said to her,
'Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again,
but those who drink of the water that I will give them
will never be thirsty.
The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water
gushing up to eternal life.'

Gospel prayer (for use throughout the week)

Lord Jesus Christ,
you are the living water
welling up into eternal life.
Draws us to that living water,
that we may drink from the well of life;
for your name's sake.
Amen.
