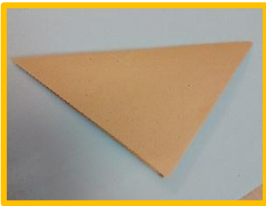
Things to think about

- What other types of guides can you think of? They might not all be human!

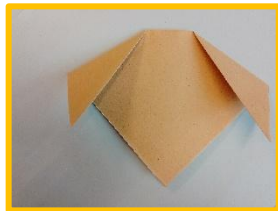
Things to do

- Make a guide for a new child starting your school. Think about things they might want to know.
- Find out how guide dogs are trained.
- Origami guide dog.

You will need: a square piece of paper, pens,



Fold the square diagonally and crease.



Fold the side corners down at an angle and crease. These will make the dog's ears.



Fold one of the bottom points up and then fold the top of that point behind to make a nose.



Draw the dog's face. Why not use googly eyes?
