THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Labourers in the vineyard (Matthew 20: 1-6)

Core extract from the Gospel (Matthew 20: 8-10; for reflection throughout the week)

Jesus said, 'When evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to this manager, "Call the labourers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and then going to the first."' When those hired about five o'clock came, each of them received the usual daily wage. Now when the first came, they thought they would receive more; but each of them also received the usual daily wage.'

Gospel prayer (for use throughout the week)

you welcome all your people
into your kingdom.
Give us grace to love you,
that we may use our lives in your service;
for you are our God.
Amen.

Things to think about

Things to do

- Create certificates to award to your family. Try to think of something for each person, unique to them!.
- Make a rosette

You will need: two colours of ribbon, cardboard, stapler or hot glue gun, scissors.



Draw and cut out two circles of card.

Pleat and staple/glue the first colour of ribbon around the edge of a card circle.



Repeat with the second colour ribbon

Glue the second card circle on top of the ribbons.



Cut two lengths of ribbon in each colour and attach to the back of the rosette
